Modernization: Attention All Providers Who Did Not Register for Modernization Training: Training Opportunities Available

The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) will implement a new, modernized Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) on February 1, 2019. To ensure Nevada Medicaid can train as many providers as possible before go-live, the following options are available for providers/delegates to attend training during the month of January even if they did not enroll prior December 31, 2018:

- Live sessions scheduled in Las Vegas and Reno: Nevada Medicaid encourages providers to attend the desired training session. View the available sessions on the <u>Training Registration site</u> or refer to <u>Web Announcement 1739</u>. Nevada Medicaid will take down the attendees' names and email addresses at registration, so they can attend the training.
- Webinar sessions: Nevada Medicaid has created a new course titled Provider Training Webinar (All Claim Form Types) where people can access and enroll in a specific session based on broad provider group and claim form submitted. The webinars will occur January 28, 2019, through February 1, 2019.
 - This course will be closed at 5 p.m. Pacific Time on January 25, 2019, to prepare for training.
 - If a provider has already registered for a webinar session prior to December 31, 2018, there is no reason to enroll in this session as their information has already been captured.
- Regardless of when a provider registers for a webinar, the link to the training session is accessed in the following way:
 - From the My Account Page on the <u>Training Registration site</u>, click the green GO button to the right of the class title.
 - Navigate to the webinar session shown and click on the calendar icon.
 - A calendar request will be downloaded, which can be opened to reveal the link.

From February 4, 2019, through March 1, 2019, Nevada Medicaid will offer webinars on submitting prior authorizations and submitting claims, claim appeals, adjustments and voids. A future web announcement will provide the details.
