## Diabetic Supply Policy Changes for Nevada Medicaid

Update to [Web Announcement 2022](#): **Attention provider types 28 (Pharmacy) and 33 (Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics and Supplies - DMEPOS)**: The following changes will be effective with dates of service on or after January 6, 2020:

- Insulin Pumps and supplies will no longer be billable under the DMEPOS benefit.
- Insulin systems and supplies and Continuous Glucose Monitors (CGM) will no longer be billable under DMEPOS when found medically necessary within the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) Program.
- Policy is being created and added to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 1200 – Prescribed Drugs, to allow for coverage of CGM systems and insulin systems and supplies.

The Pharmacy Billing Manual and the PT 33 Billing Guide will be updated along with the MSM Chapter 1200 and 1300 updates.

Effective with dates of service on or after January 6, 2020, only the preferred products (and their corresponding test strips) listed below will be covered. Recipients who are legally blind may obtain specialized monitors through the prior authorization process.
