Nevada Medicaid Updates Reimbursement of COVID-19 Vaccines

Nevada Medicaid has updated the reimbursement rates for the 2023-2024 COVID-19 vaccine formulations. Pharmacies will now be reimbursed for the ingredient cost for recipients 19 years of age and older.

For information on provider vaccine reimbursement rates, the Vaccine for Children (VFC) program, and incentive fees for COVID-19 vaccines, please refer to the sections under 5.4 of the Pharmacy Manual.

Pharmacies can re-bill for updated reimbursement for claims with dates of service (DOS) on or after 9/11/23. For instructions on re-billing claims, please refer to section 3.3.1 of the Pharmacy Manual titled Supported POS Transaction Types.

Note: Pharmacies must enroll in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program. VFC vaccines are provided at no cost to the provider by the Nevada State Health Division for recipients who are under 19 years of age.
