Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3372

Attention Provider Type 60 (School Health Services): Update on Funding for School Services

Effective with dates of service on or after July 1, 2024, all Medicaid-covered school-based health services will be covered by Nevada Medicaid at no cost to localities, and the county or local governments will not need to finance the state share (via the Intergovernmental Transfer (IGT) fiscal model). An *IGT* is a transfer of *funds* from another governmental entity (e.g., a county or other state agency) to the Medicaid agency before a Medicaid *payment* is made. With the new process, school health services claims will no longer pend and will allow for faster payment of claims.

Please note: The IGT model will **still be effective for services provided up to and including June 30, 2024**. School districts are encouraged to ensure that matching IGT funds are made available so that claims with dates of service prior to July 1, 2024, will process with minimal delays.
