Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3373

Attention All Providers Billing Dental Services: 5% Rate Increase Approved for Dental Services

During the 82nd Nevada Legislative Session (2023), Senate Bill (SB) 504 approved a 5 percent rate increase for dental services performed by any provider type allowed to provide dental services. The adjusted rates have been entered in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) and are effective with dates of service on or after January 1, 2024.

The impacted provider types are:

- 17 (Special Clinics)
- 20 (Physician, M.D., Osteopath, D.O.)
- 22 (Dentist)
- 60 (School Health Services)

Any impacted claims submitted for dental services with dates of service on or after January 1, 2024, that did not reimburse per the updated rates will be reprocessed automatically at a later date. Results of any reprocessed claims will be reported on a future remittance advice.

When claims are reprocessed, please be aware that all system and clinical claim editor edits are applicable. As a result, there may be no additional payment, and other claim denials may be received. Providers have the right to appeal denied claims, including those denied upon reprocessing. Please refer to Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 100 and the Billing Manual for information concerning the claim appeal process and time frames.
