## Reminder: Nevada Medicaid and Nevada Check Up Managed Care Organization (MCO) 2024 Open Enrollment

Managed Care Organization (MCO) Open Enrollment is once a year from October 1 through October 31 of each year. Requests to change MCO plans must be received by October 31, 2024, to be effective January 1, 2025.

Recipients have multiple options to submit MCO Open Enrollment change requests this year:

- Use the NVMedicaid app starting October 1, 2024, to choose a new health plan. Recipients go to MyForms to start the process. They will need their case number, PIN and last four digits of the head of household's Social Security Number. Recipients may obtain and register for the app at mdp.medicaid.nv.gov. - Complete the form on the back of the MCO enrollment letter, which was sent in July of 2024, and either:
  - Take a picture and email it to: <u>NVOpenEnrollment@Gainwelltechnologies.com</u>.
  - Mail it to: NV Medicaid, MCO Changes, P.O. Box 30042, Reno, NV 89520.

All MCO change requests received after **October 31, 2024**, will not be honored. If recipients are not satisfied with their choice, they will have 90 days from the effective date to make one (1) final MCO change. Once this final change has been processed, recipients will remain locked in the selected MCO until the next open enrollment period, which will be October 1 through October 31 of 2025.

It is important for recipients to update their contact information with the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) as soon as possible to receive all communications regarding their eligibility. Their contact information should include their residence and mailing addresses, phone number or message number, and email address, if available.

Recipients may update their information at <u>https://accessnevada.dwss.nv.gov/public/landing-page</u>. They will need to create an account and also may sign up for paperless notifications.
