Justice Involved Reentry Initiative: Eligible Provider Types

The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 (CAA, 2023) section 5121 addresses Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) requirements for certain beneficiaries who are incarcerated. Effective January 1, 2025, under this Act, Medicaid and CHIP will provide physical (diagnostic) and behavioral health screenings to eligible juveniles within 30 days of their release from an institutional setting. Additionally, Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment (EPSDT) services, as well as 30-day pre- and post-release targeted case management (TCM) services will be included.

The following provider types (PT) will be eligible to enroll with Medicaid to offer these services:

- PT 20 – Physician, M.D., Osteopath, D.O.
- PT 22 – Dentist
- PT 24 – Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN)
- PT 54 – Targeted Case Management
- PT 77 – Physician's Assistant (PA/PA-C)
