Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3494

**Attention Provider Types 14 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment) and 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment):**

**Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Certification Requirements**

Applicants for Qualified Mental Health Associates (QMHA) and Qualified Behavioral Aids (QBA) seeking to enroll in Nevada Medicaid as a provider type 14 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment) or 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment) are required to submit a Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Certification Card to fulfill the Initial Competency Training requirements.

All requirements are specified in the [Medicaid Service Manual \(MSM\) Chapter 400, Mental Health Services, Section 404.3](#). See [Web Announcement 2842](#) more information about Initial 16-Hour Competency Training Program Requirements. Please note that a signature from a certified instructor **is not required** on the CPR certification card.
