

## April 7, 2025 Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3603

## Attention Providers Who Submit Serious Occurrence Reports (SOR): Web-Based SOR Form Removed from Nevada Medicaid Provider Website

Effective April 7, 2025, the web-based Serious Occurrence Reporting (SOR) will no longer be available on the <u>Nevada Medicaid</u> website under Forms. The weblinks for SOR and the NMO-3430A form will be disabled and removed.

As of March 31, 2025, providers are required to submit their SORs through the Aging and Disabilities Services Division (ADSD) <u>new</u> Case Management System called Therap. In the Therap system, SORs are known as "General Event Reports" (GER). All providers included in this Web Announcement must submit SORs/GER for their Fee-for-Service or Waiver recipients.

SORs can no longer be reported by using the web-based form. Prior to submitting a SOR/GER, all providers must first create an account with Therap in order to submit SORs. If you have not already signed up with Therap, please immediately contact <a href="mailto:nvsupport@therapservices.net">nvsupport@therapservices.net</a>. Because SOR/GER are time sensitive reports, it is imperative that all providers have an account with Therap as soon as possible.
