Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 400 - Mental Health Services were made to align with federal requirements for Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF) and to restore Biofeedback and Neurotherapy services policy for the treatment of a mental health diagnosis.

- MSM Chapter 2500 – Case Management (effective March 26, 2025)

Changes were made to provide pre- and post-release case management, screening, and diagnostic services for eligible youth who are under age 21. Aged out foster youth up to age 26 who are post-disposition for 30 days prior to their release also may qualify. In the 30 days prior to release and for at least 30 days following release, targeted case management (TCM) services, including referrals to appropriate care and services available in the geographic region of the home or residence of the eligible juvenile, where feasible, under the Medicaid State Plan, would be available.
