## Attention All Providers, Delegates and Staff: Upcoming Provider Flex Overview Training Session Update

The Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP), Nevada Medicaid, and the Gainwell Technologies Provider Training team would like to remind all Nevada Medicaid providers, delegates and staff of the upcoming transition to an enhanced provider enrollment tool, Provider Flex. All providers, delegates and/or staff are invited to attend a Provider Flex Overview training session. Beginning May 1, 2025, the sessions will drop from eight (8) to four (4) sessions per day.
