Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3763

Attention Provider Type (PT) 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment): Sunsetting Provider Type

Provider type (PT) 82 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment) specialties 882 (Group), 300 (Qualified Mental Health Professional), 301 (Qualified Mental Health Aide), and 302 (Qualified Behavioral Aide) will begin phasing out January 1, 2026.

Effective July 1, 2026: PT 82 and all its specialties will no longer be available for enrollment in Provider Flex. All existing requests and revalidations will be rejected, and providers will be advised to select their most appropriate provider type for enrollment from the provider types available.

Enrolled PT 82 providers are encouraged to start this transition and enroll under the most appropriate provider type based on the services rendered to avoid claim denials. When enrolling under a new PT, providers are allowed to use their existing National Provider Identifier (NPI). For awareness, PT 14 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment) currently has services available which are most closely aligned to services available under PT 82.

PT 82 providers enrolling in new Medicaid PTs will not be allowed to backdate their new provider type while transitioning from a PT 82.

Effective December 31, 2026: All PT 82 claims must be submitted for payment. No claims with the date of service on or after January 1, 2027, will be accepted.

Effective June 30, 2027: All PT 82 enrollments will terminate. Providers must be enrolled in another Medicaid PT to continue billing on or after July 1, 2027.

A future web announcement will have details regarding prior authorizations under PT 82.
