Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3834

Attention Provider Types (PT) 14/300 (Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment) and PT 82/300 (Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment):

Qualified Mental Health Professionals (QMHP) Will Be Limited To Clinical Interns Only

Effective immediately, only the following three professionals (interns) will be allowed to enroll as Qualified Mental Health Professionals (QMHP) under Behavioral Health Outpatient Treatment (provider type [PT] 14 specialty 300) and Behavioral Health Rehabilitative Treatment (PT 82 specialty 300):

1. Licensed Master Social Worker (LMSW) (Clinical Social Worker-Intern) with a current clinical post-graduate internship number and current letter of internship issued by the State of Nevada Board of Examiners (BOE) for Social Workers (Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 641B)
2. Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT-I) Post-Graduate Intern issued by the State of Nevada BOE for MFT & Clinical Professional Counselor (NRS 641A)
3. Clinical Professional Counselor (CPC-I) Post-Graduate Intern issued by the State of Nevada BOE for MFT & CPC (NRS 641A)

Other professionals shall enroll in the PT that is specific to their specialty, for example:

Physicians (PT 20); Physicians' Assistants (PT 77); Psychologist (PT 26); Advanced Practitioner of Nursing (APRN) (PT 24); Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) (PT 14 specialty 305); Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (PT 14 specialty 306); Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC) (PT 14 specialty 307)

Providers who are currently enrolled as a PT 14 specialty 300 and/or PT 82 specialty 300 and are not clinical interns will be required to correct their PT or specialty upon the next update or revalidation application. Providers who need to change their PT, and not only the specialty, will be required to submit a new enrollment. Providers have the option to enroll under their correct PT or specialty at any time but must do so upon an update or revalidation application.
