Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3843

New Specialty 320 (Medicaid Health Home for Beneficiaries with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder [FASD]) Under Provider Type 85 (Applied Behavior Analysis) is Available for Enrollment

Follow-up to [Web Announcement 3829](#): New specialty 320 (Medicaid Health Home for Beneficiaries with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder [FASD]) under provider type (PT) 85 (Applied Behavior Analysis) is now available for enrollment through the [Provider Flex](#) tool. Eligible providers may backdate their enrollment effective date to October 1, 2025. All enrollment requirements are listed in the [Provider Enrollment Information Booklet](#).

Once a provider is enrolled and active as a PT 85 specialty 320, they may begin to submit claims under their new specialty following the billing requirements. These requirements can be found in the new Billing Guide, which is posted on the [Billing Information](#) webpage. Please note that the [PT 85 Specialty 320 Eligibility Checklist](#) must be submitted with the initial claim for the recipient, for claims with dates of service on or after October 1, 2025. After the initial claim is approved, subsequent claims do not require the Eligibility Checklist, regardless of date of service or provider.

[Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 4200](#) – Medicaid Health Home for Beneficiaries with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) has been created with the policy for health home providers serving recipients with FASD.
