**Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3888**

## **Update to FA-11 Behavioral Health Outpatient or Rehabilitative Authorization Request Form**

The Behavioral Health Outpatient or Rehabilitative Authorization Request Form (FA-11) has been updated and replaced on the Nevada Medicaid Provider Portal website on the [Providers Forms](#) webpage.

The changes to this form include the following:

- Added Plan of Care language because Peer Support Specialists will also utilize this form.
- Added a “Certified Peer Support Specialist Supervisor or Peer Clinical Supervisor Attestation” section which will be required if Peer Support Services are requested.
- Replaced “Coordinating QMHP Attestation” with “Licensed Professional or QHMP Attestation” because QHMPs are limited to Clinical Interns only. Reference [Web Announcement 3834](#).
- Removed Clinical Supervisor Attestation previously required for Mental Health and Behavioral Health service requests. Per MSM Chapter 400, Clinical Supervisors are required to sign Treatment Plans.

Providers are requested to discontinue use of the previous version of the form and use the updated form dated 04/09/2026.

Beginning May 8, 2026, requests for Behavioral Health Outpatient or Rehabilitative services submitted on any previous version of the form will be returned to the provider and the provider will need to resubmit the request on the updated form.
