Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3907

Attention Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics and Supplies (DMEPOS) Providers: DMEPOS Federal & Statewide Moratorium

On February 27, 2026, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) implemented a six-month federal moratorium on new Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS) provider enrollments. In response, Nevada Medicaid implemented a corresponding moratorium.

As a result, all new DMEPOS enrollment applications received on or after February 27, 2026, will be denied for the duration of the moratorium. This restriction does not apply to revalidations, changes of ownership*, and updates to existing enrollments.

Nevada Medicaid has an enrollment moratorium exemption process in place and may approve exceptions for applicants seeking to furnish services in areas where access to care concerns exist. Applicants wishing to request a moratorium exemption must complete and submit the [Enrollment Moratorium Exemption Request form](#) along with their online Nevada Medicaid enrollment application.
