## **Pregnancy Presumptive Eligibility (PPE) Training Calendar Dates and Sign-Up Guidelines**

All Pregnancy Presumptive Eligibility (PPE) staff are required to recertify every two (2) years. To meet this requirement, the Division of Social Services (DSS) will be conducting quarterly PPE trainings for the following provider types (PT) who would like to participate in the PPE determination process:

- 17 (Special Clinics) Specialty 166 (Family Planning)
- 17 (Special Clinics) Specialty 169 (Licensed Birth Centers)
- 17 (Special Clinics) Specialty 180 (Rural Health Clinics)
- 17 (Special Clinics) Specialty 181 (Federally Qualified Health Centers)
- 17 (Special Clinics) Specialty 182 (Urban Indians FQHC)
- 20 (Physician) Specialties 062, 124, 129 (Obstetrics/Maternal Fetal Medicine specialties)
- 24 (Advanced Practiced Registered Nurses)
- 47 (Indian Health Programs)
- 74 (Nurse Midwife)
- 77 (Physician's Assistant)

Please note that the PPE training courses are available to staff only; this does not include contract staff and third-party billing services. The mandatory training is a two-day, virtual training course scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Pacific Time each day. Please see the training schedule for 2026 below:

- July 13 – 14, 2026
- October 12 – 13, 2026

To qualify for PPE enrollment training, addendums and sign-up sheets **must** be completed, signed by the Qualified Entity Administrator or Chief Executive Officer, and approved by Nevada Medicaid 10 business days prior to the date of the requested training. If the 10-day deadline is not met, the provider will need to wait to sign up for the next available training session.
