Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3922

Attention Provider Type 22 (Dental): Endodontics Claims May Have Paid in Error

Some dental claims submitted with procedure codes D3110–D3999 may have paid in error when a previously paid claim exists for a different dental procedure performed on the same tooth number.

The procedure codes for the historical claim are below:

- D7111 – Extraction, coronal remnants (primary tooth)
- D7140 – Extraction, erupted tooth or exposed root
- D7210 – Extraction, erupted tooth requiring removal of bone and/or sectioning of tooth
- D7220 – Removal of impacted tooth (soft tissue)
- D7230 – Removal of impacted tooth (partially bony)
- D7240 – Removal of impacted tooth (completely bony)
- D7241 – Removal of impacted tooth (completely bony, with unusual surgical complications)
- D7250 – Removal of residual tooth roots

Effective May 18, 2026, claims submitted with procedure codes D3110–D3999 will deny correctly with error code 6110 (Dental services allowed per lifetime) if a historical claim with one of the above codes for the same tooth number was paid.

Claims for procedure codes D3110–D3999 that processed on August 14, 2023, through May 18, 2026, and paid in error will be reprocessed automatically. Results of the reprocessed claims will appear on a future remittance advice.

When claims are reprocessed, please be aware that all system and clinical claim editor edits are applicable. As a result, there may be no additional payment, and other claim denials may be received. Providers have the right to appeal denied claims, including those denied upon reprocessing.
